The theme of the project is temporal attention and anticipation. This position is for one year initially, with potential for extension for up to three years (in total), subject to progress in the project.

Candidates should have a PhD in neuroscience, psychology, cognitive sciences, biomedical engineering, physiology, or a related field. Having a knowledge of non-human primate handling, electrophysiology, animal behavior, data analysis, and programming (specially MATLAB) is highly desirable.
