

Postdoctoral opening in the intersection of neuroscience, psychology and philosophy of mind

Job description

The successful applicant will be working on the problems arising in cognitive science (involving issues in the philosophy of mind, psychology and modern neuroscience). The candidate must be adept in using such tools as fMRI and electrophysiology. The applicant will be assigned two supervisors one from the school of analytic philosophy and the other from the school of cognitive science at IPM.

What do we need?

- Candidate should have a PhD degree.
- The candidate should have the relevant academic background and research experience in at least two of the following three fields: Psychology, Neuroscience and Philosophy.
- The candidate should be able to work in a multidisciplinary environment, have good communication skills and be proficient in the English language.

What do we offer?

The duration initial contract is 24 months which is extendable for another 12 months pending approval from the school of cognitive science's scientific committee.

This is a fully funded postdoctoral position according to the IPM regulations.
